Information about your video recording in the preliminary round

Dear participant of the Dutch International Flute Competition for Students and Young Talents 2021 and the Dutch International Piccolo Competition Students 2021,

We are happy to confirm that your application for our competition for the 2021 competition is valid. In case you have previously applied for our canceled 2020 competition, your application for the 2021 competition is still valid.

The numbers of participants for each category are:

76 bachelor students, 49 master students, 36 young talents, 17 piccolo students.

The participants come from all over the world!

The preliminary rounds of the competition take place online.

Please send a link of your YouTube videorecording to: secretaryflutecompetition@gmail.com **before May 1st .2021.**

You are requested to submit one single, unedited videorecording with your piece for flute/piccolo with piano/marimba and your piece for flute/piccolo solo. The two pieces may be recorded at different times and/or locations and at a later time linked up to one video. You must not exceed the performance time of 20 minutes and must take pauses between movements and/or pieces and time for tuning into account.

You must record with a fixed camera standpoint and ensure that the piano/marimba and the pianist/percussionist are to be seen. You should ensure the video is filmed indoors and has a neutral background, without visible personal belongings.

You start your video recording by clearly mentioning in English your name and the pieces you are going to play.

If you have given us permission, your video recording may be published on our website and our social media from May 1st onwards.

From May 1st through 31st our adjudicators will adjudicate the video recordings. Rating scores will be given for musicality and technique 1 to 10* up 1 decimal each. The maximum score will be 60 points. Each participant is adjudicated by 3 adjudicators.

The highest total scores determine who will be shortlisted for the final round.

15 participants will play in the final round for bachelor students. This final round will take place on Thursday October 21st..2021. This date has changed since our first announcement.

10 participants will play in the final round for master students. This final round will take place on Friday October 22nd .2021.

6 participants will play in the final round for young talents. This final round will take place on Saturday October 23rd. .2021.

6 participants will play in the final round for piccoloists. This final round will also take place on Saturday October 23rd..2021.

On June 6th .2021 you will receive an e-mail whether or not you are shortlisted for the final round and in which range of rating you have ended in the preliminary round. Each individual adjudicator will write down some focus points on which you might study in the future.
