### Category 1, Bachelor:

#### Preliminary round:

Choose one of the works below:

F. Devienne (1759-1803) Concert in e-flat no.7, part 1 Allegro and part 2 Adagio

J. Binet (1893-1960) Kaval for flute and piano

And a work for flute solo, free of choice. It is allowed to choose a work from the final round.

#### Final round:

Choose one of the works below:

J.A. Stamitz (1745-1801) Rondo capriccioso G-dur

P. Hindemith (1895-1963) 8 Stücke, parts 1 and 2 and 3 and 8

And a work, or parts of it, for flute and piano, free of choice. It is allowed to choose a work from the preliminary round.

### Category 2, Master:

#### Preliminary round:

Choose one of the works below:

J. Feld (1925-2007) Sonate for flute and piano, part 1 Allegro giocoso and part 2 Grave

R. Groslot (\*1951) Suite for flute and piano, part 1 Prelude and part 2 Seguidilla

And a work for flute solo, free of choice. It is allowed to choose a work from the final round.

#### Final round:

Choose one of the works below:

E. von Dohnany (1877-1960) Passacaglia for flute solo

L. Berio (1925-2003) Sequenza per Flauto solo

And a work, or parts of it, for flute and piano, free of choice. It is allowed to choose a work from the preliminary round.

### Category 3:

#### Young Talent up to (and including) age 13:

#### Preliminary round:

Choose one of the works below:

W.A. Mozart (1756-1791) Andante in C, KV 315

E. Kronke (1865-1938) Suite im alten Stil für Flöte und Klavier

Ph. Gaubert (1879-1941) Sonate for flute and piano no.1, part 1 Modéré and part 2 Lent

P. Hindemith (1895-1963) Sonate for flute and piano, part 1 Heiter bewegt and part 2 Sehr langsam

And a work for flute solo, free of choice. It is allowed to choose a work from the final round.

**Final round:**

*Choose one of the works below:*

B. v.d. Sigtenhorst Meyer (1888-1953) Landelijke miniaturen

A. Lourié (1892-1966) Sunrise

And a work, or parts of it, for flute and piano, free of choice, in which a work for flute and piano can also be chosen from the preliminary round.

**Young Talent age 14 up to (and including) age 18:****Preliminary round:**

*Choose one of the works below:*

G.Ph. Telemann (1681-1767) Sonatina 1 e-flat, part 1 Andante and part 2 Allegro

W.A. Mozart (1756-1791) Rondo in D

R. Batton (1879-1940) Passacaglia

J. Mouquet (1867-1946) La flûte de Pan, 2 parts of your choice

And a work for flute solo, free of choice. It is allowed to choose a work from the final round.

**Final round:**

R. Escher (1912-1980) Air pour charmer un lézard
