General information

- Check your dates and information and correct any **errors and changes** immediately.
- **Competition location:** Adams Music Centre, Aziëstraat 17-19, 6014 DA Ittervoort, Netherlands, <https://www.adams-music.com/festival/?fid=13&lid=1033>
- See enclosed: **Route planner** and **time table** to the Flute Competition. During the competition days, Adams Music Centre shuttle buses drive free of charge from the railway station Weert to Adams Music Centre and to the group accommodation Bekerhof.
- See enclosed the information about the group accommodation: **General Information Group Accommodation Bekerhof**.
- If you have no **reservation** for the group accommodation, but would like to stay one or more nights, please contact the competition secretary. There is still room available. Each night costs € 35,00, including breakfast, a hot meal and transport vice versa to the location of the competition and railway station Weert.
The group accommodation is also the **meeting point** for the participants of the competition.
- Please sign up on arrival at the **service desk** of the Flute Competition upstairs in the hall of Adams Flute Centre.
- The preferred **language** is English.
- Every participant has 40 minutes **warming-up** time with piano. If you play with a competition pianist you'll be appointed 40 minutes **to rehearse**.
- The maximum **performance time** is 20 minutes, including the time between pieces/parts of pieces. Please check the **Participants regulations** and the **List of compulsory pieces**.
- Please give the jury secretary **three copies** of each score before your performance. You have to use the original score yourself. It is not necessary to bring copies of the compulsory pieces.
- If you would like a **page turner** for the pianist, please request this when signing up at the service desk.
- During the competition days catering for **drinks and lunch** is available at the location of the competition (extra charge).
- At the end of both the morning program and the afternoon program, the **reports of the adjudicators** are handed out by the adjudicators themselves.
- At the end of the preliminary rounds on Wednesday April 15, the **semi-finalists** will be announced in the demo-hall at 6:00 pm.
- Check the schedules for the **announcements** of the (semi-) finalists. You will get a call when you are selected. If you get no phone call, you won't be playing in the (semi-)final round.
Verify your **mobile number** on the participants form. Otherwise pass on the correct number immediately to the competition secretary or check your number at the service desk on arrival.

- The **playing time table** of the (semi-)final round will be announced the same evening by mail and on the website.
- During the **semi-final** round on Thursday April 16, three bachelor students and three master students will be selected for the final round. They will **rehearse** with the orchestra in the concert hall at 7:00 pm.
- The **final round** with orchestra will take place on Friday April 17, in the afternoon. The competition will be concluded with a **final concert**.
- **Audience** is welcome (free entrance).
