Please give the jury secretary **three copies** of each score before your performance. You have to use the original score yourself. It is not necessary to bring copies of the compulsory pieces.

If you would like a page turner for the pianist, please request this when signing up at the service desk.

At the group accommodation Bekerhof

Each night costs €40 including breakfast, a take-away lunch prepared by the participant him/herself at breakfast, a cooked meal, bedding with duvet and transport vice versa to the location of the competition and railway station Weert.

There will be a full time **housekeeper** and a day cook.

The Bekerhof is a converted farmhouse with very simple facilities:

- o Gender-separated dormitories, showers and toilets are available.
- The dining room provides enough space for all.
- Practicing is possible in the lounge and the dorms.

You have to bring your own towels.

Breakfast will be served **from 07:30** until 10:00 o'clock. A simple hot meal from 18:30 onwards. Please let the competition secretary know in advance if you prefer **vegetarian food**. Drinks are available at the competition location **(extra charge)**.

Please pay special attention to:

- o At the group accommodation only cash money can be accepted.
- o Take good care of your properties.
- o Don't leave **valuables** at the group accommodation.
- o Flutes and luggage can be left in a safe place at Adams Music Center.
- Neither the Dutch International Flute Competition board nor Adams Music Center can be held responsible for any loss or damage.

The group accommodation can be used for the days you have reserved for. If you wish to extend your stay, you have to arrange and to pay the extra night(s) to the house keeper of the group accommodation. The group accommodation is **available** from Monday 16:00 o'clock until Sunday 12:00 o'clock.
